

Requests of the Alte Münze Work Group of the Coalition of the Independent Arts



26.04.2018

Prerequisite/foundation: The management of the development of the administrative model and usage concept rests with Berlin's Senate Department for Culture and Europe.

1. The building Alte Münze will become a location for culture whose non-commercial cultural usage is formalized in a guaranteed public administrative model with no expiration date.
2. The administrative model and usage concept for Alte Münze as a location for culture will be developed in an open, transparent and participatory process.
3. Politicians (on the local, state and federal levels), all relevant Senate departments, BIM, the Alte Münze Work Group of the Coalition of Independent Arts/the Coalition of Independent Arts and the independent arts community with all of its discipline will be equally involved in the development of the administrative model and usage concept, as equals.
4. All participants agree
 1. To make a binding commitment to participation from the very beginning,
 2. To a notion of mandate/right to a have voice that is clearly defined in advance,
 3. To provide information about dates, deadlines and documents in a timely manner.
 4. To form a steering committee with all participants named in the application.
 5. To agree to a binding schedule of the individual steps with all participants named at the beginning of the project.
 6. To appoint a person accepted by the stakeholders named for process management, documentation and moderation.
5. That a workshop employing the international best practice examples of non-commercial locations for culture be conducted in order to develop the administrative model.
